## what should happen every day?

1. **Be prompt.** You must be in your seat by the time the bell is done ringing.

# What's Miss Fladda's Grading Policy?

#### what's the deal with homework?

Homework assignments *may* be checked or collected the day after it is assigned. Homework that is checked for completeness will be assessed on whether there is genuine effort to complete it. "Work" includes pictures, drawings, explanations, shortened versions of the questions asked, and any mathematical calculations. NO WORK, NO CREDIT!!! Some weeks, rather than checking homework daily, we will have a homework quiz at the end of the week. These quizzes will include one or two problems from the homework. Late work will be accepted for 50% credit until the day of the chapter test.

#### what if I'm absent?

If you are absent, you have as many class days as you were absent to make up the work you missed. For extended illnesses, please contact me as soon as possible to make arrangements. Exceptions: A class cut will result in a zero and an official office referral. For an in-school suspension and/or a school-related field trip, the work must be obtained in advance and is due the day you return to class. For out-of-school suspensions please e-mail me or call the office to get your assignments.

## what's the cheating policy?

Cheating is a very serious offense. I have great compassion for students who are struggling with the material in math class. I have none for those who choose to cheat. If I have reason to believe you are cheating, the following consequences will occur: 1) you will earn a zero on the test/quiz/assignment 2) I will immediately contact the office and your parent/guardian to arrange a conference.

## what is the test correction policy?

Students have the opportunity to retake one chapter assessment per quarter. The retake must be scheduled within 5 days upon return of the test, at a mutually agreeable time

I am always available to help, either before or after school or during my planning period. If you have any questions, please, please, please set up a time to meet with me. Once you fall behind, it's hard to catch up. The e-book also has a homework help link on each problem to assist you if you are struggling. This year, we will be doing lots of work in study teams, so be sure to ask questions and work with your team as needed.
